- 0.2 This specification has been approved by the Ministry of Defence and is mandatory for use by the Defence Services.

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#### 1. SCOPE

1.1 This specification is meant to govern manufacture, supply and quality assurance of Boards, Carton for Ammunition suitable for use in the manufacture of Carton for Ammunition.

#### 3. MANUFACTURE AND FINISH

- 3.1 The material shall consist of good quality, well-sized board with pure Kraft lining on one face. It shall possess good securing and bending properties and the plies shall adhere firmly together. The board shall be uniform in thickness, free from holes, hard spots and lumps and shall lie flat and be dimensionally stable. Both sides of the board shall be clean and free from loosely bound fibres and loading.
- NOTE: The adhesive used shall be starch paste to IND/ME 532 (c) or casein glue to IND/ME/381(b) when pure craft lining is present and shall be approved by the Quality Assurance Officer prior to use. No modifications in the adhesion shall be made without the consent of the Quality Assurance Authority.

## 4. <u>TENDER SAMPLE</u>

4.1 The contractor shall submit a tender sample of 1 kg conforming do this specification, free of charge.

#### 5. PRE-INSPECTION OF STORES/CONSIGNMENT

- 5.1 Manufacturer/contractor must satisfy themselves that the stores are in accordance with the terms of the contract and fully conform to the required specification, by carrying out a thorough pre-inspection of each lot before actually tendering the same for inspection to the Quality Assurance Officer nominated under the terms of the contract. A declaration by the contractor that a necessary pre-inspection has been carried out on the stores tendered, will be submitted along with the challan The declaration will also indicate the method followed in carrying out pre-inspection showing the features checked/tested and will have the test certificate attached to the challan/declaration.
- 5.2 If the Quality Assurance Officer finds that pre-inspection of the consignment as required above has not been carried out, the consignment is liable for rejection.

### 6. **QUALITY ASSURANCE**

#### 6.1 <u>Inspection</u>

6.1.1 The material shall be subject to inspection by and to the final approval of the Quality Assurance Officer/Quality Assurance Authority. Samples of the material may be taken from any portion of a consignment.

#### 6.2 <u>Sampling</u>

6.2.1 Not less than 5 per cent of the packages shall be sampled. The representative test sample, not less than 0.5 kg., shall consist of sheets of at least 30 x 30 cm.

#### 6.3 Criteria for conformity

- 6.3.1 If on examination, any sample is found not to conform to this specification, the whole batch/lot/consignment may be rejected.
- 6.3.2 The foregoing provisions shall apply equally to prime contractors and to any sub contractors.

#### 6.4 Test Requirements

6.4.1 Samples taken from any portion of the supply of material shall conform to clause 3 and in addition shall conform to the test requirements: -

<u>Note</u>:- All percentages shall be calculated on the dry mass material after drying to constant mass.

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#### (b) **Physical**

The material shall be conditioned, prior to test, for 24 hours in an atmosphere of  $65 \pm 2$  per cent relative humidity at 27°C+2 deg C. The material shall be capable of making carton, without any cracks during creasing, scoring or stamping. No crack will be visible on folded edges.

The sample shall comply with the following physical requirements: -

#### 7. <u>WARRANTY</u>

The stores supplied against the contract shall be deemed to be warranted against 7.1 defective material and performance by the contractor for a period of 12 months from the date of receipt of the store at the consignee's end and if during this period any of the stores supplied defective replaced is found the same shall be by the supplier/manufacturer/contractor free of charges at the consignee's premises.

#### 8. PACKAGING

8.1 50 or 100 boards (according to the thickness of boards on order) shall be wrapped in paper to form a packet. 10 such packets shall be packed with a single layer of hessian cloth to form a bale. The bale will be placed between two suitable thick boards (wood or paper), one on top and one at bottom and the assembly banded all round by hoop iron, for safe rail transit.

OR

Packaging (Preservation, identification and packing) shall be in accordance with the terms of the contract.

#### 9. MARKING

- 9.1 All bales containing the material shall be indelibly and legibly marked with the following details: -
  - (i) Nomenclature and specification number of the material
  - (ii) Name and address of the consignee
  - (iii) A.T or S.O number and date
  - (iv) Consignment number
  - (v) Batch No. and date of manufacture
  - (vi) Gross and net mass.
  - (vii). Consecutive number of package and total number of packages in the consignment
  - (viii) Date of supply.
  - (ix) Manufacturer's initials or recognised Trade mark.
- 9.2 In addition to the above, the Quality Assurance Officer may suggest some more markings/identifications suitable at the time of inspection.
- 9.3 The paint used for marking should conform to IS 138 and to the satisfaction of the Quality Assurance Officer/Quality Assurance Authority.
