GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS :

This advertisement is for developing additional sources hence –

(i) Firms who are established suppliers of a particular item / holding supply order as on date need not apply for the same.

(ii) Firms possessing necessary manufacturing facility and meeting the core competence as per the pre-qualification criteria only shall apply otherwise the application will be summarily rejected.

1.1 The firm should submit the following details –

- a) Tentative process schedule for manufacturing the item.
- b) Details of machine to be used for manufacturing the item.
- c) Heat treatment process – in house or outsourcing.
- d) If any outsourcing, MOU copy to be attached.
- e) Quality plan for manufacturing process including the processes outsourced.
- f) Measuring instruments, gauges, measuring equipment / devices.
- g) Details of manpower.
- h) Material testing lab details whether NABL accredited.
- i) List of similar components already manufactured and supplied successfully with details of suppliers.
- j) Company Profile.
- k) P&M list.
- l) Last 3 years financial statement copy.
- m) Submission of online vendor registration request form (VRRF) duly filled.
- n) NSIC/DGQA/ any Ord Factory registered certificate if any
- o) ISO certificate if any.
- p) Details of successfully completed supply orders in the last 3 years.

1.2.1 The firm should also submit an assessment fee in the form of DD in favour of GM/EFA , along with necessary valid documents as mentioned at para (1.1), to carry out the capacity verification as given below.

1.2.2 In case the firm owns more than one unit for manufacture of the product, the same can be agreed to. However, the firm will have to pay separate registration / assessment fee for both the units as given below.

“ Charging additional assessment fee will be essential as visit of capacity verification team is required for assessment to second unit owned by the firm. Once the capacity of both units are verified, the firm will be registered for supply of stores from any of the units for that particular item / process for which registration has been done.”

1.3 Firms who are satisfying the above requirement at para 1.1 to 1.2 will be considered for capacity verification by designated officers from EFA.

1.4 Firms who have qualified in the capacity verification for the items will be provided with vendor registration certificate accordingly and TE will be issued later on. The vendor registration will be valid for a period of 5 years. The same may be renewed by putting specific request with application.

1.5 T.E. (Tender Enquiry)will be issued only through e-portal. The firm should possess valid class III digital signature certificate. For further details refer website www.cca.gov.in. No manual quotation will be considered.

1.6 Wherever critical components subject to performance test will be carried out on test stand, the firm should be in a position to create the facilities at firm premises to carryout testing of pilot sample

(or)

The firm should have MOU with the firm having similar facilities for testing.

2. Tender / Supply Order conditions are governed by the provision of OFB procurement manual 2010.

3. Bulk production clearance (BPC) will be accorded after confirmation of all the parameters specified in the drawings, then the component will be subjected to engine test after fully assembled condition. After satisfying the test in the test bed, the same assembly shall be mounted in the tank trial for 500KM, after confirmation of all the parameters and satisfying the functional requirement the BPC will be accorded. From the date of submission of sample to BPC clearance will take minimum six months.
